No. 1 of the Privacy Policy Annex

The purpose of this abstract data management prospectus (hereinafter: the Prospectus), which forms Annex 1 to the Data Management Regulations, is that **MGV Magyar Gazdaság- és Vállalkozásfejlesztő Zártkörűen Működő Részvénytársaság, Aulich utca 7., CSO statistical code: 24721617-6492-114-01, tax number: 24721617-2-41**), further inform the data subject of the data protection and data management principles, rules and regulations applied and respected by the Data Controller prior to the establishment of a contractual relationship (eg a contractual relationship) with the Data Controller regarding the data processing performed by the Data Controller.

This prospectus applies to data processing performed in connection with the data controller's customers as natural persons. Detailed rules are contained in the Privacy Policy.

1. Data Controller

2. The Data Controller draws the attention of the owner of the personal data to the fact that a contractual relationship (such as a contract) may be established between the Data Controller and the customer if the customer, as the owner of the personal data, consents to the data controller's knowledge and processing.

3. The Data Controller publishes the current Data Management Regulations on its website (www.mgv.hu) in electronic form, and makes them available on paper at the Data Controller's headquarters at 7 Aulich út, 1054 Budapest. If the owner of the personal data submits an electronic or paper-based application, the Data Controller shall send the Data Management Regulations as an attachment to an electronic mail to the electronic mail address provided by the owner of the personal data.

4. The purpose of the data processing performed by the Data Controller in relation to the customer is to: (i) fulfill the obligation, fulfill the rights and fulfill the obligations arising from the obligation through the data processing based on the consent of the data subject; (ii) the fulfillment of legal obligations incumbent on the controller and (iii) the exercise of a legitimate interest of the controller.

The legal basis for the data processing performed by the Data Controller in relation to the Customer is: (i) the consent of the Customer; (ii) compliance with a legal obligation to the Data Controller; (iii) performance of a contract; (iv) the protection of personal data rights or the vital interests of another natural person; (v) Enforcing the legitimate interest of the Data Controller.

The scope of the data processing performed by the Data Controller in relation to the customer: (i) the data content of the personal identification data of the natural person, such as the personal identification card of the holder of the personal data, the official identity card certifying the address, the official identification card; (ii) the bank account number of the holder of the personal data and the name of the financial institution holding the bank account, depending on the nature of the legal relationship; (iii) the contact details of the holder of the personal data (telephone number, email address); (iv) in the case of a party to a legal person, the surname and forename of the natural person authorized to represent the legal

person; office; place and date of birth; mother's birth name; permanent address or, failing that, residence address.

5. The Data Controller will only transfer the customer's data to another person if v) if the data transfer is required by law (eg statistical data collection; the obligation to provide data imposed on the employer) and the data transfer is addressed to the Company by a court, authority or other body; vi) if the data subject has given his or her express consent and the recipient of the data transfer is a person with a legal relationship with the Company, and the data transfer is the fulfillment of a legal relationship between the owner of the personal data and the Company.

6. The Data Controller shall store the personal data for the period and in the manner specified in the Data Management Regulations from the time the consent is given.

7. The Data Controller draws the attention of the owner of the personal data to the fact that he / she operates a camera system at his / her registered office, premises and branches in order to protect the real estate and movables he / she owns or uses.

8. Rights of the holder of personal data: The natural persons whose personal data are processed by the Data Controller have the following rights with regard to the data processing of the Data Controller: a.) The right to information. b.) the right to rectification; c.) the right to be forgotten; d.) the right to restrict data processing; e.) the right to data portability; f.) the right to protest.

9. Remedies: If the owner of the personal data finds that the Data Controller violates the provisions of the data protection legislation regarding the processing of his / her personal data, he / she may apply to the territorially competent court or the National Data Protection and Freedom of Information Authority in order to protect his / her rights.
